- Meeting called to order by Ryan Vaughn
- Teacher Update
  - Teachers reviewing iready assessment scores – reviewing growth, achievement, areas of focus going forward; iready growth scores at PGE highest in reading they have every been (5th in district)
  - Panther Pride Award – recognizing kids who are consistently meeting school values; 2 kids per month nominated per class. They will get their name over announcements, certificate, email to parents, celebration in library. This aligns with focus on positive reinforcement.
- Principal Update
  - Review budget and enrollment for 24-25
    - Enrollment current count in Oct '23 is 466
    - Enrollment projected about 450 next year. Discussion on difficulty of projection
    - Last year, we were able to add Assistant Principal, Educational Assistant to support literacy and classroom instruction and .6 certified math interventionist. We don't anticipate adding any new positions this year.
    - Discussed importance of curriculum and effects of budget with less enrollment projected in the 24-25 year. Benchmark Advanced is paid by

district and will be renewed. Math and ELA iReady will be renewed;  
Technology bond from 2018 expired – PGEA approved a grant to purchase  
technology in place of the bond this year.

- Passing of 5A has helped morale & turnover
- New Position: Campus Security Specialist
  - Campus Security Specialist Position – With 5A passing, every elementary school was provided budget for a new CSS position. This position has been hired and will start at PGE at the end of the month.
- DAC Update – Update on monthly DAC meetings (relevant to PGE - discussions on 5A, discussions having a specific DAC email for PGE/DAC communication)
  - Glen is now a district employee and, therefore, cannot serve as the DAC liaison
