- Meeting began at 6:08 PM by Jaimie Wolf
- Mr. Richard Payne, from DCSD Safety and Security, gave overview of the various safety and security procedures for DCSD
- Meeting minutes from 20 January tabled until review
- Pricipal update:
  - Enrollment: 546 students for next year
  - Possible full-day Kindergarten impacts on retention of half-day
    - Maybe revisit at next SAC meeting once we have numbers for full-day kindergarten

- Staffing: Hired a counselor with our MLO funds; five sections for 1st grade to reduce class size
- Bond money: \$50,000 for tech refresh priority for staff to get computers that are less than 4 years old
- Mill Levy Money: Removed the paper, Expo markers, and pencils from the school supply list because the Mill Levy money will cover those assets
- Teacher Update: CMAST testing happening currently, lowest opt-out rate
- DAC Update
  - March meeting focused on mental health and decreasing the ratio of counselors to students
- Possible new community liaison, proposed by Nate Jenson
- PGEA Update
  - Grants for playground equipment and Eagle Scouts will build gaga pit; technology grant and chromebooks for 3, 4, 5, and 6 grades
  - All PGEA positions got filled; Julie Jenson will replace Katie Ehlers as SAC liaison
- Open discussion
  - SAC is being asked to review the school district policies applied to disciplinary actions at PGE and how they are applied
