- May 15, 2018 Meeting minutes unanimously approved
- Discussion of bylaws
 - Missing presence of Community Member (rule is cannot have a child at the school), request for nominations for new Community Member
- Schedule of future SAC meetings (Tentative)
 - Special October 18 (tentative) meeting featuring Bright Futures to promote Ballot Initiative, coordinated by Jaimie Wolf
 - Possible feeder-wide meeting open to community similar to presentation by Erin Kane last year

 - Budget
 - April 16, 6 pm
 - Safety
 - May 14, 6 pm
 - Introduction of new members
- Bond/MLO Initiative
 - Every Elementary school would get funding in their budget for school counselor
 - If passed, PGE teachers would get retroactive pay in their Dec paycheck
 - PGE would get Tier 1 need met to replace and upgrade HVAC
- Resolution
 - Morgan McCorkle made motion to add PGE SAC as signatories to Resolution on Ballot Measure; seconded by Kristina Kocsis; unanimously approved
- Principal update
 - 3 goals
 - Increase reading comprehension
 - Increase student engagement
 - Focus on positive teacher/student relationship
 - Review of Continuous Process Improvement (CPI) to attain these goals
 - Enrollment is at 556, projection was 550
 - Assessment Day was well received by staff
 - Possible survey for all families in March focusing on Safety and Programming
 - Review of TLCC survey

 - First year w/iReady (which replaced STAR)
 - PGE purchased the online instructional piece so teachers could have small groups work independently
 - How are children being accountable for extra reading?
